- After school care is for K3 - 6th grade. Cost is \$10 per day per student or \$150 per month per student. Any student picked up after 5:30 p.m. will be charged \$12 for every 15 minutes beyond that time.
- Students attending one or more days of school in a month will owe for the entire month.
- All charges are due on the first school day of each month. A \$50 late fee will be charged on all accounts not paid by the 10th of each month.
- Students whose account is one month past due will be withdrawn from school until the account is made current.
- A \$40 fee will be charged on all returned checks.
- A 10% discount will be given if total yearly tuition is paid in advance of July 1, 2022.
- Mandatory school fundraisers may be necessary throughout the year. If fundraising is deemed necessary, the administration will communicate details in advance.
- Student accounts must be paid in full before the release of school records.

Standards of Conduct

Central Baptist School holds that the Bible is the infallible, divine Word of God and that salvation by faith in Christ is the initial step in the Christian life. There is adequate Biblical basis for the idea of spiritual growth into the image of Christ (Romans 8:29), which is the work of the Holy Spirit (II Corinthians 3:18). This growth begins at the initial moment of saving faith and continues throughout life. The Holy Spirit makes the Christian conscious of the Biblical demands for a holy life which fulfills both God's moral law and high law of love (Matthew 22:37-39; Romans 13:8-10; Galatians 5:14). The result is a life consecrated unto God and separated from worldly activities.

A sense of the need for spiritual growth in our students has led Central Baptist School to adopt the following standards which are based upon biblical principles and are conducive to the spiritual growth and development of young people. Students are expected to abide by the following standards throughout their enrollment, whether at home, school, or elsewhere and regardless of whether or not school is in session.

- Maintain Christian standards in courtesy, kindness, honesty, morality, dress, and entertainment.
- Avoid participation in worldly activities such as swearing or indecent language; inappropriate online or social media content; body piercing or tattoos; smoking in any form, including e-cigarettes and vaporizers; possession or use of alcoholic beverages, drugs, tobacco, or related products; involvement in the occult; gambling; stealing; dancing; pornography; premarital sex; promoting or participating in homosexual or transgender lifestyles or other lifestyles contrary to Scripture; involvement in rock-style, rap music, any other form of ungodly music or so-called "Christian rock/rap" music.
- Refrain from harassment, fighting, violence, or threats of any kind regardless of provocation; public disruptions or exhibitionism in any form; promoting division or a divisive spirit through symbols, pictures, writing, flags, banners, slogans, gang related items, or any divisive activism.

Students found to be out of compliance or harmony with Central Baptist School's Standards of Conduct will be subject to administrative withdrawal. Any student who has been arrested by public law enforcement authorities will be suspended until such time as that student is adjudicated either guilty or not-guilty. Any student who adjudicated guilty will be subject to administrative withdrawal from Central Baptist School.

Central Baptist School may accept students and families who do not claim to be Christians; however, our desire is to see all of our students become Christians. Whether or not a student has made a personal decision to be a Christian, each student will be expected to abide by these Standards of Conduct and maintain Christian standards. Attendance at Central Baptist School is a privilege, not a right.

In such cases, the school reserves the right to have full discretion in the discipline of every student, to place such students on probation for a reasonable corrective period of time, and to dismiss any student who does not cooperate with the total educational process.

PARENT PLEDGE:

I recognize that Central Baptist School has a qualified, trained staff and I have confidence in their ability to perform the educational functions due my child.

I realize that from time to time children take issue with actions that they do not agree with and that they are prone to criticize statements out of context. This being normal for children, I pledge that should such occur, I will not support the criticism, that I will correct my child, support the school personnel, and call in for full details at any time I have a question concerning an incident.

I further realize that building strong relations with my child's supervisor to aid in the training of my child is as much my responsibility as it is the school's, and that I will pray for the staff and program, cooperate with them in discipline accepting their judgment in such matters, lay a spiritual foundation through Godly example in the home, support the spiritual training of chapel, revivals, etc., follow through with any work assignments or slips to be signed, see that the children reach school on time, phone or send written excuses for absence or tardiness, cooperate in training the children to respect school property and pay for irregular abuse of the same, attend all parent functions, and assist in publicizing the school and its programs among friends.

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Parent/School Agreement

In order to solemnify the desire of the undersigned parties to glorify the Lord with their obedience to Him and to promote a clear understanding of the duties and responsibilities of each party, the undersigned parties adopt the following Agreement:

I, _____, for and in consideration of my child _____, being admitted as a student at Central Baptist School, do hereby accept such admission and the duties and responsibilities entailed therein and agree to be bound by the terms of this Agreement.

- I subscribe without reservation to the Statement of Faith and the Standards of Conduct of Central Baptist School and agree that my family will abide by these doctrines in all aspects of our lives, both at and away from school ministries and functions.
- I understand and agree that the church and the school ministry are inseparable and that my child may be expelled from the school if either of us is out of fellowship with the church, as determined in sole discretion of the pastor and church leadership.
- I have read and understand the Central Baptist School Handbook and I agree with it completely. I agree that my child and I must abide by the policies, rules, and regulations of the school, including those listed in the Handbook, and I agree to support Central Baptist School with my conduct and my prayers.
- I understand and agree that the education of my child will be guided by the instructors and other school officials. I agree that my purpose in obtaining a Christian education for my child will be achieved by following the curriculum set by the instructors. To that end, I agree that I will require my child to perform all duties and responsibilities entrusted to him by the instructors and school officials to the best of his/her ability to their satisfaction. I will support the decisions of the instructors and school officials and will never attempt to undermine their authority. I understand and agree that during my child's enrollment, the courses offered and the instructors teaching them may change from time to time at the discretion of the school leadership.
- I understand and agree that my child has no right to publish and distribute a student newsletter or any other publication. I understand and agree that Central Baptist School has the right, in its sole discretion, to control what is published, circulated, or otherwise distributed at its school to its students or staff, and I will ensure that my child understands this provision.
- I understand and agree that attending Central Baptist School and the Summer Day Camp program is a privilege and the school reserves the right to suspend or expel my child from the Summer Day Camp in accordance with its official policies as determined by the school. Notwithstanding anything to the contrary contained herein, this Agreement does not bind either party to any specific period of enrollment. Either party may terminate this Agreement without cause upon a seven (7) days' notice. I understand that no rights or presumptions of continued enrollment are conferred or implied by this Agreement or by a number of consecutive Agreements. I further agree that no right to notice of renewal or non-renewal of the Agreement is conferred or implied.



- I agree to pay all tuition and fees in a timely manner as set forth in Central Baptist School's Admission Packet. I understand that monthly tuition payments are due on the first day of each month. I further understand that if I fail to make timely payments, my child may be withdrawn from Summer Day Camp and I may be subject to late-payment fees and other costs, including any necessary costs of collections in accordance with school policy.
- As Central Baptist School is a Christian ministry organization, both parties agree that they would never make demands, threaten to sue, or actually litigate any matter whatsoever relating to or resulting from this Agreement. I understand that making demands, threatening to sue, or actually litigating a matter against Central Baptist School or Central Baptist Church clearly violates Biblical teaching and practice and shall constitute sufficient grounds for immediate withdrawal of all my children from enrollment at Central Baptist School. I understand that retaining or instructing an attorney to contact the ministry with regard to a potential claim or dispute will be interpreted as a threat to sue. Accordingly, the parties agree to resolve all potential claims, disputes, or causes of actions through binding arbitration using the procedures outlined in the attached procedures.
- I agree to follow the Biblical pattern of Matthew 18:15-17 and Galatians 6:1 and always give a good report. All differences are to be resolved by utilizing Biblical principles – always presenting a united front.
- The parties agree that the methods outlined in this section shall be the sole remedies for any and all controversies or claims arising out of the employment relationship or this Agreement and expressly waive their right to file a lawsuit against one another in any civil court for such disputes, except to enforce a legally binding arbitration decision.
- I agree to do everything in my power to avoid involving Central Baptist School or Central Baptist Church in any legal proceedings that may take place or legal requests for documents or testimony of school officials concerning the custody and/or education and upbringing of my child. I understand that if in spite of my attorney's and my best efforts, any school official is legally compelled to provide testimony or documentation beyond a copy of my child's standard academic records, my child may be immediately un-enrolled from Central Baptist School Day Camp and my account may be charged for any and all expenses incurred in complying with such legal process.
- The parties agree that there are no other agreements or understandings between them relating to the subject matter of this Agreement. This Agreement supersedes all prior agreements, oral or written, between the parties and is intended as a complete and exclusive statement of the agreement of the parties. Neither this Agreement nor its execution have been induced by any reliance, representations, stipulations, warranties, agreements, or understandings of any kind other than those expressed herein. If any provision of this Agreement is found to be void or voidable, it shall not affect the validity of any other provision. Both parties shall remain bound by all provisions.
- I certify that I will explain this Agreement and its meaning to my child. I will assist the school in every way necessary to ensure my child abides by all the terms of this Agreement.
- I understand that this Agreement shall not take effect until fully executed by all parties.
